The IAWP is sad to announce the passing of Hamilton (Ontario, Canada) Police Service (retired) Jessie Stoneman. Jessie was part of Region 11 and an IAWP Life member.

Jessie received the Dr. Lois Higgins-Grote Heritage Award in 2001 from the International Association of Women Police. She was a long-time Life Member of IAWP (February 1, 1985) and a member of Ontario Women in Law Enforcement. Jessie was a pioneer in the Hamilton Police Service. On May 25, 2007, Jessie received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Sexual Assault Centre of Hamilton and Area where the always humble Jessie, the city's first female cop, told the 500 people attending the award night that she "felt very honored to be up here with all these wonderful women." Jessie will be greatly missed.
