In 2012 she was re-deployed as Assistant Commissioner for anti-Human Trafficking, ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING UNIT. The Section is headed by an Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP Mary A. Egbeyemi). The Unit works in collaboration with the UNICEF, National Agency for the Prohibition of Trafficking in Persons and other Related Matters (NAPTIP), International Labour Organization, United Nation Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), Federal Ministry of Women Affairs, Federal Ministry of Labour and Productivity, United States Agency for International Development (USAID), America Bar Association (ABA), Nigerian Organization for Migration. These joint actions were mapped out for the eradication of human trafficking. She was subsequently promoted to Deputy Commissioner of Police.
