Members of the International Association of Women Police (IAWP) will converge on Las Vegas in March for a regional training conference.

Law enforcement officers are expected to travel far and wide to attend the two day conference entitled 'Striving and Thriving in Law Enforcement'. Topics include: Human Trafficking, Crime Scene Investigation, Career/Leadership, and Officer Safety.

The IAWP has members in over 65 countries around the world and its mission is to strengthen, unite and raise the profile of women working within criminal justice.

The IAWP, which celebrates its centenary year in 2015, is segmented into regions around the world of which 1-10 cover the USA. The Las Vegas conference has been organised by US based regions 9 and 10.
